Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) violations have increased **1.6 times** over the past five years.

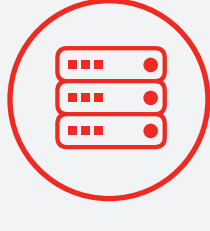
Healthcare Cyber Loss Sources

32% of Protected Health Information (PHI) losses involved printed records between 2006-2011, increasing to **45%** between 2011-2016.

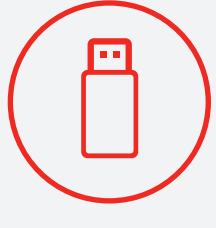

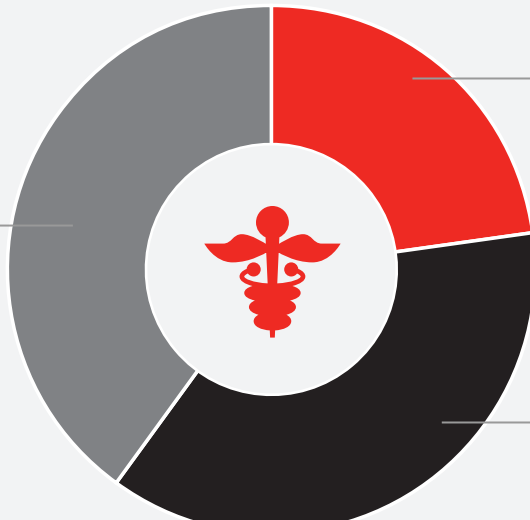
